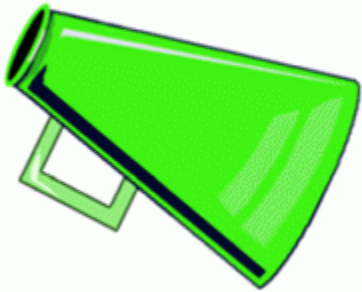
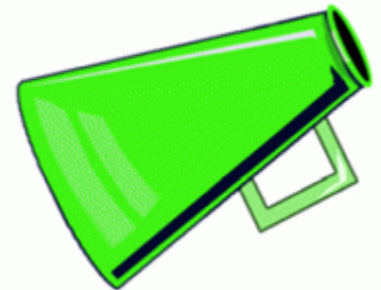

Please circle the scholarships that you qualify for and bring your selections to Mrs. Czornomor **ASAP**. You will be provided with the required documents at that time.

The application deadline is Monday, March 4, 2019.

No applications will be accepted after that date!!!!

- **If a scholarship has an essay requirement you must make sure you have the sheet containing the essay question.**
 - **Essays must be typed, neatness counts!**
 - **If a scholarship requires letters of recommendation, Mrs. Czornomor will copy the recommendations that are already in your college file. (Please let Mrs. Czornomor know whether you have letters in your file.)**
- **If a letter from a certain person (i.e. fireman, club advisor, community organization, etc.) is required, you must obtain those letters and submit them with your scholarship application.**
- **It is the student's responsibility to submit a copy of their SAT Scores with their applications! You can print out your score from the College Board (www.collegeboard.com).**
- **It is the student's responsibility to make sure they have a completed transcript authorization form on file. Without this form, scholarship applications will not be accepted. For your convenience, a form is attached for those who have not yet completed one.**
- **Everything should be returned to Mrs. Czornomor who will submit everything on your behalf to the organizations. Do not drop off the applications as you will sign your name for verification once Mrs. Czornomor checks your applications in.**
