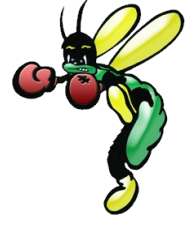


Scholarships

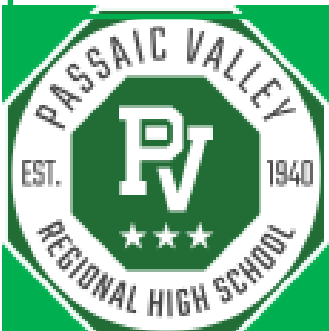
