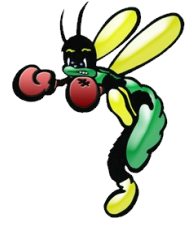


Scholarships

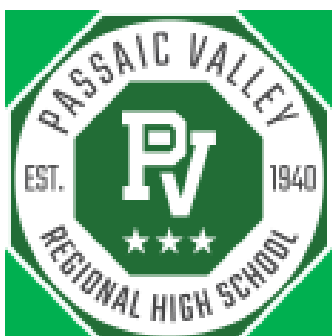
