Week of September 21-25, 2020 Schedule Change

Dear Passaic Valley Community,

It is important for everyone to read and understand the information in this letter as it represents a schedule change for the week of September 21, 2020.

Passaic Valley accepted the offer College Board presented to all high schools to administer the S.A.T on Wednesday, September 23, 2020 during the school day. Our choice to participate in this special one-day exam administration opportunity is to support our seniors who have been unable to take the exam during the COVID-19 crisis this spring and summer.

The following schedule adjustment makes sure students will not lose an in-person day of school. The change affects Wednesday, September 23 and Friday, September 25. Please adhere to the following:

- Monday, 9/21- Full Virtual Day of learning for all. No change
- Tuesday, 9/22 - **Red** Team will report to school. No change
- **Wednesday, 9/23 –**
 - **Only PV seniors who have registered and paid for the S.A.T will report to school by 8:00 am to take the S.A.T exam.**
 - All other students, *including seniors who are not testing*, will log in virtually and complete the assignments prepared by their teachers.
- Thursday, 9/24 - **Blue** Team will report to school. No change
- **Friday, 9/25 - White Team will report to school.**

Why is Wednesday, September 23, 2020 a virtual asynchronous day? Because teachers will be administering the S.A.T test. We will be using every classroom in the building to assure social distancing protocols. Thus, teachers cannot live stream lessons at the same time as the testing takes place.

Monday, September 28, 2020, Passaic Valley will return to our regular hybrid schedule. Again, this schedule change represents our continued commitment to our students and at this time specifically our seniors, so they can prepare for their post-secondary choices during the 2020-2021 school year.
