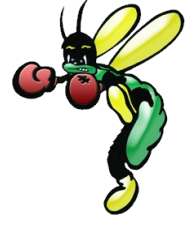


Scholarships

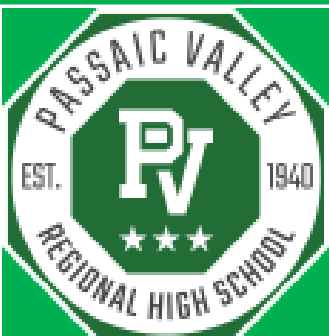
