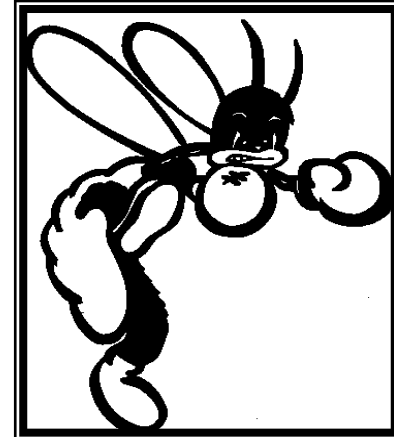


REASONS TO GET INVOLVED @ PVHS
