6. Go to a Doctor or Med-Express and get an updated physical
7. Turn in Physical to NURSE
8. Get an IMPACT test here at PV with the TRAINER. Make and appointment with trainer, Brendan Byrnes
9. If you failed any classes be sure to check with your GUIDANCE COUNSELOR about eligibility
10. COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR COACH! Email them, be in touch with them! Find out when tryouts/practices start.

NO SPORTS will practice from Saturday, July 27 – Sunday, August 4
Your guardian MUST complete the online registration packet!
You MUST have a physical to be eligible for the fall season!
YOU must take an ImPact test in order to be able to play.
All FALL sports BEGIN their season the week of Monday, August 12
